Parish Website launching soon!



What's been happening since May?

Well your parish council members have been busy in setting up to meet the needs and improvements of the Parish.

- We have been in a number of consultations with Northampton Borough Council regarding our current and future funding, opening a bank account, seeking opportunities to apply for grants from central government, and seeking out an enthusiastic and professional clerk to ensure our ability to work within the law and government guidelines. So what's been achieved so far?
- We have badgered the borough to improve the overall quality of the Children's play area and this is planned to happen before the end of January.
- Improved the unsightly roadside mound by arranging for 5 tons of top soil and for 1000+ daffodils to be planted
- Improved the quality and frequency of grass cutting
- Financed the installation of an electronic speed awareness device, about to be installed on Banbury Lane. We hope to finance another in the coming months.
- Financed an additional parish noticeboard to be sited at the entrance to the Pineham Lock Development within two to three weeks. Applied for possible noticeboard sponsorship by David Wilson Homes. (Awaiting final decision).
- Planning and Financing: "Welcome to Hunsbury Meadows. Please Drive Carefully" road signs as you drive into Hunsbury Meadows from either end.

• Purchase and Installation of: Neighbourhood Watch" road signs where Neighbourhood Watch schemes are in place. Completed.

• Chasing the Borchigh Council to sponsor and maintain additional dog poo bins in strategic positions. Bins to be installed soon! Litter bins next.
