

- "body in which the relevant person has a beneficial interest" means a firm in which the *relevant person* is a partner or a body corporate of which the *relevant person* is a *director*, or in the *securities* of which the *relevant person* has a beneficial interest;
- "director" includes a member of the committee of management of an industrial and provident society;
- "land" excludes an easement, servitude, interest or right in or over land which does not carry
  with it a right for the relevant person (alone or jointly with another) to occupy the land or to
  receive income;
- "member" includes a co-opted member;
- "relevant period" means the period of 12 months ending with the day on which you give a notification for the purposes of section 30(1) (notification of DPIs upon becoming a member or coopted member) or section 31(7) (notification of DPIs not currently on the register that you become aware of), as the case may be, of the Localism Act 2011;

- "relevant person" means:
  - o you
  - o your spouse or civil partner

  - a person with whom you are living as husband and wife; or
    a person with whom you are living as if you were civil partners;
- "securities" means shares, debentures, debenture stock, loan stock, bonds, units of a collective investment scheme within the meaning of the Financial Services and Markets Act 2000 and other securities of any description, other than money deposited within a building society.
