NIGEL PERRIN

Nigel is a former boy chorister at Ely Cathedral from where he won a choral scholarship to King's College, Cambridge, to study under Sir David Willcocks. On leaving Cambridge Nigel became a founder member of The Kings Singers in which he sang the higher counter tenor part.

His international career includes conducting, directing choral workshops, summer schools, adjudicating and teaching.

Having established Bath Camerata as one of the country's leading chamber choirs, he is greatly sought after as an inspiring choral conductor, directing the City of Bath Bach Choir, the Bath Festival Chorus and the Exeter Festival Chorus.

ANDREW KING

Andrew is one of Northamptonshire's leading teachers and performers on piano and organ.

At age 9 he became a chorister at St Paul's Cathedral. He studied music at Jesus College, Cambridge where he was Organ Scholar, and afterwards moved to Northampton. Andrew now works as a freelance teacher, pianist and organist in South Northamptonshire.

He has toured widely in the UK, Europe, USA, Canada, Singapore, Poland and New Zealand. Andrew has had a number of compositions and arrangements recorded and broadcast on radio and television.
