  - Speed awareness campaign in Pineham Village.
  - Additional litter bins in Pineham Village.
  - Helped establishing legal ownership of various stretches of hedges and land within Hunsbury Meadows.
  - Installed two defibrillator units within the Parish.
  - Participated in the Plantscape project to landscape the Parish.
