3	Minutes : The council confirmed the approved minutes of the Annual Parish Meeting of 3td May 2023 as circulated.
4	Public Participation: none
5	Chairs review of the past year:
	The chair thanked fellow councillors, members of the public and the clerk for their support and contribution during the year. A chairs report was presented (circulated) and covered the following
	 aspects: Council Changes: Acknowledgement of the departure of Councillors John Kwijuka, Stacey Lloyd, and Parish Clerk Lalit Patel, and the appointment of new Parish Clerk Mrs. Jennie Allwork. Environmental Efforts: Installation of planters and fence baskets, replanting of bulbs, maintenance of the tow path by IWA and Cummins, and addressing issues with wildflower strips and an overflowing ditch. Transport and Communication: Ongoing issues with potholes, bus infrastructure and routes, and verge cutting on Upton Valley Way East. Community Initiatives: Development of an Emergency Plan, exploration of green spaces for community use, and the formation of a Pineham Village Residents Association. Planning applications received: 80 Houses on Upton Valley Way North: The Parish Council and residents objected to the proposed development due to flood risk concerns. 5G Mast Banbury Lane: Despite 65 objections regarding its appearance and suggested alternative sites, the planning for the 5G mast was approved with minimal concessions. New Bus Stops – Upton Valley Way East: The Parish Council is pressing for the installation of promised bus stops as part of the planning agreement for new houses. Canal Bridge – Pineham Lock: The Parish Council opposed the construction of a bridge due to environmental impact and potential noise pollution from future warehousing.
